Martha was born in Pendleton/Scott, Kentucky 17 MAR 1844. She was christened in Kentucky, aft 1844. Martha was listed as the head of a family on the 1850 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Martha is listed as a seven year old member of the John Tingle household.

She married John Wesley O'Banion in Kentucky, 09 JAN 1861. John listed as 20 yrs old and born in Owen Co., Martha listed as 17 and born in Scott Co. on the marriage license. Marriage performed at home of James Perkins 09 JAN 1862.

Martha became the mother of Sarah 'Sarabet' 'Sarrie' Elizabeth O'Banion in Kentucky, circa 1862. At 19 years of age Martha became the mother of George Washington O'Banion in Kentucky, December 1863. Martha became the mother of Isabelle O'Banion in Owen Cty., Kentucky, circa 1865. Martha became the mother of Harriet Ellen O'Banion in Owen Cty., Kentucky, circa 1868. Martha became the mother of Mary Susan 'Sue' O'Banion in Kentucky, circa 1868. Peggy O'Banion genealogy 1962 suggests birth on July 3rd.

At 26 years of age Martha became the mother of Joel 'Joe' O'Banion in Kentucky, 27 NOV 1870. At 28 years of age Martha became the mother of John 'Jonney' Wesley O'Banion Jr. in Owen Cty., Kentucky, 1872. At 31 years of age Martha became the mother of Robert 'Bob' Samuel O'Banion in Owen Cty., Kentucky, 23 DEC 1875. Martha became the mother of Jephtha 'Jep' O'Banion in Owen Cty., Kentucky, circa 1877. At 37 years of age Martha became the mother of Anna 'Annie' O'Banion in Owen Cty., Kentucky, 1 JUN 1881. At 38 years of age Martha became the mother of Kathryn 'Kate' 'Katie' B. O'Banion in Kentucky, 09 MAR 1883. At 41 years of age Martha became the mother of Lucinda Lula O'Banion in Scott County, Kentucky, 24 JAN 1886. Lucinda's place of birth is listed as Owen Co., Ky on her marriage certificate and an LDS record suggests that the year of birth may have been as early as 1883.

At 43 years of age Martha became the mother of Effie Jane O'Banion in Scott County, Kentucky, 1 JAN 1888. Date of January first supported by Peggy O'Banion 1962 genealogy.

She was listed as a resident in the census report in East Owenton, Owen Cty., Kentucky, 1910. Martha died 09 JAN 1916 in Grant County, Kentucky, at 71 years of age. Her body was interred 1916 in Kentucky.

### 2 John 'Jeff' Tingle

John was born in Scott County, Kentucky 1822. John was listed as the head of a family on the 1830 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. He married ? ? in Kentucky, bef 1839. John became the father of Eliza Jane Tingle ca 1839. He married Ellen 'Pop' Mary Barnhill in Scott County, Kentucky, 30 MAR 1843. Wedding information based on Virginia K. Tolman notes.

John became the father of Martha A. Tingle ca 1843. At 21 years of age John became the father of Jephtha Tingle in Kentucky, AUG 1843. At 21 years of age John became the father of Martha Jane Tingle in Pendleton/Scott, Kentucky, 17 MAR 1844. At 25 years of age John became the father of Harriet Ellen Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1847. He married Nancy ? in Kentucky, bef 1850. Nancy listed as 30 yrs old and as a member of the John Tingle household in the census of 1850 for Scott Co., KY.

John was listed as the head of a family on the 1850 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. John is listed as a thirty year old farmer in the 1850 Census of Scott Co., KY. at line 700.

John was listed as a household member living with Jephtha Tingle on the 1850 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Jephtha is listed as a seven year old member of John Tingle's household.

John was listed as a household member living with Martha Jane Tingle on the 1850 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Martha is listed as a seven year old member of the John Tingle household.

John was listed as a household member living with Harriet Ellen Tingle on the 1850 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Harriet is listed as a 3 yr old member of the John Tingle household.

John was listed as a household member living with Martha A. Tingle on the 1850 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Martha listed as a seven year old member of the John Tingle household.

John was listed as a household member living with Eliza Jane Tingle on the 1850 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Eliza listed as an eleven year old member of John Tingle's household.

He married Elizabeth Betty O'Banion aft 1850. John became the father of George Tingle aft 1850. John died bef 1880 in Kentucky. His body was interred bef 1880 in Kentucky, Muscell Shoals Baptist Church.

### **3 Ellen 'Pop' Mary Barnhill**

Ellen was born in Pendleton Cty., Kentucky aft 1824. Ellen as daughter of Robert and Margaret, as well as marriage to John Tingle recorded in the EE Barton Papers on the Barnhill Family. Virginia Tolman references John Tingle's first marriage to Mary Barnhill.

She married John 'Jeff' Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 30 MAR 1843. Wedding information based on Virginia K. Tolman notes.

At 18 years of age Ellen became the mother of Jephtha Tingle in Kentucky, AUG 1843. At 19 years of age Ellen became the mother of Martha Jane Tingle in Pendleton/Scott, Kentucky, 17 MAR 1844. At 22 years of age Ellen became the mother of Harriet Ellen Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1847. Ellen died bef 1850 in Kentucky. Her body was interred bef 1850 in Owen Cty., Kentucky.

### **4 Jephtha Tingle**

Jephtha was born in Sussex Co., Delaware 1786/90. He married Harriett ? in Scott County, Kentucky, bef 1811. At 25 years of age Jephtha became the father of Calvin Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1811/15. Jephtha was listed as the head of a family on the 1820 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Jephtha listed on reel number 124 at line 18.

At 35 years of age Jephtha became the father of John 'Jeff' Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1822. At 38 years of age Jephtha became the father of Harriett Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1825. At 39 years of age Jephtha became the father of William Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1826. At 42 years of age Jephtha became the father of ? Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1829. Jephtha was listed as the head of a family on the 1830 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Jephtha listed on page 164 of the 1830 Census.

Jephtha was listed as the head of a family on the 1850 Census in Kentucky. Listed as 60 yr old head of household and laborer.

### **5 Harriett ?**

Harriett was born in Kentucky 1791. She married Jephtha Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, bef 1811. At 21 years of age Harriett became the mother of Calvin Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1811/15. At 31 years of age Harriett became the mother of John 'Jeff' Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1822. At 34 years of age Harriett became the mother of Harriett Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1825. At 35 years of age Harriett became the mother of William Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1826. At 38 years of age Harriett became the mother of ? Tingle in Scott County, Kentucky, 1829. Harriett was listed as the head of a family on the 1850 Census in Kentucky. Listed as 60 yr old wife of Jephtha.

### **6 Robert Barnhill Sr.**

Robert was born in Washington Co., PA 1793. Robert served in the military in Kentucky, 08 FEB 1815. Robert served until 07 March 1815.

He married Margaret Neeley in Scott County, Kentucky, 17 AUG 1815. Robert became the father of James Barnhill in Scott County, Kentucky, aft 1815. Robert was listed as the head of a family on the Frederick L. Lager

1820 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Robert listed on reel number 99 at line number 25.

At 31 years of age Robert became the father of John Barnhill in Kentucky, 1824. Robert became the father of Ellen 'Pop' Mary Barnhill in Pendleton Cty., Kentucky, aft 1824. Ellen as daughter of Robert and Margaret, as well as marriage to John Tingle recorded in the EE Barton Papers on the Barnhill Family. Virginia Tolman references John Tingle's first marriage to Mary Barnhill.

Robert became the father of ? Barnhill aft 1824. Robert was listed as the head of a family on the 1830 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Robert listed at page 171 of the 1830 Census

At 37 years of age Robert became the father of Sarah 'Sallie' Barnhill in Kentucky, 1830. At 40 years of age Robert became the father of Robert Barnhill 1833. At 43 years of age Robert became the father of William Barnhill 1836. Robert served in the military in Mexico, 1848. Robert is listed as having served in the Mexican War.

He migrated 1849. Robert's occupation: Farmer in Pendelton Co., KY., aft 1849. Robert died 20 MAY 1872 in Pendelton Co., KY., at 78 years of age. His body was interred 1872 in Pendelton Co., KY., Mt. Auburn Cemetery.

## 7 Margaret Neeley

Margaret was born in North Carolina 1790. Barnhill Papers of EE Barton suggests that Margaret may have been born in PA. LDS AFN V4PL-DV suggests that Margaret was possibly born as early as 1785 near Nelson / Washington, KY.

She married Robert Barnhill Sr. in Scott County, Kentucky, 17 AUG 1815. Margaret became the mother of James Barnhill in Scott County, Kentucky, aft 1815. At 34 years of age Margaret became the mother of John Barnhill in Kentucky, 1824. Margaret became the mother of Ellen 'Pop' Mary Barnhill in Pendleton Cty., Kentucky, aft 1824. Ellen as daughter of Robert and Margaret, as well as marriage to John Tingle recorded in the EE Barton Papers on the Barnhill Family. Virginia Tolman references John Tingle's first marriage to Mary Barnhill.

Margaret became the mother of ? Barnhill aft 1824. At 40 years of age Margaret became the mother of Sarah 'Sallie' Barnhill in Kentucky, 1830. At 43 years of age Margaret became the mother of Robert Barnhill 1833. At 46 years of age Margaret became the mother of William Barnhill 1836. Margaret applied for a military pension in Kentucky, 18 JAN 1879. Margaret filed application (WO 34396) based on Roberts service in the War of 1812. The pension was rejected on the grounds that the rolls showed less than 14 days of service prior to 17 FEB 1815.

Her body was interred aft 1879 in Pendelton Co., KY., Mt. Auburn Cemetery.

## 8 John Tingle

John was born in Sussex Co., Delaware 1760/65. Based on records of Virginia K. Tolman.

He married ? ? in Delaware, bef 1780. John became the father of John Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, aft 1780. At 20 years of age John became the father of Kindle Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1780/84. At 21 years of age John became the father of Malissa Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1782. At 24 years of age John became the father of Sarah Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1785. At 26 years of age John became the father of Jeptha Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1786/90. At 26 years of age John became the father of Nancy Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1787. At 31 years of age John became the father of David Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1792. At 40 years of age John became the father of ? Tingle in Fayette Co., KY., 1800/10. At 40 years of age John became the father of James L. Tingle in Fayette Co., KY., 1800/10. John died 1824/25 in Scott County, Kentucky, at 64 years of age.

She married John Tingle in Delaware, bef 1780. ? became the mother of John Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, aft 1780. ? became the mother of Kindle Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1780/84. ? became the mother of Malissa Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1782. ? became the mother of Sarah Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1785. ? became the mother of Jeptha Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1786/90. ? became the mother of Nancy Tingle in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1787. ? became the mother of David Tingle

in Sussex Co., Delaware, 1792. ? became the mother of ? Tingle in Fayette Co., KY., 1800/10. ? became the mother of James L. Tingle in Fayette Co., KY., 1800/10.

## 12 Samuel Barnhill

Samuel was born in Bucks Co., PA. 29 OCT 1761. Based on revolutionary war pensions application S. 10344, Samuel may have been born on December 29th 1761.

He was inducted into the military in Cumberland Co., PA., DEC 1776. Samuel served as a private in Captain Mitchell's company of Colonel Watts' Pennsylvania Regiment for two months. He participated in the march to Trenton. He enlisted next in 1778 and served two months as private in Captain Thomas Clark's Company of Colonel Abram Smith's Pennsylvania Regiment, and participated in the battle of Crooked Billit. In 1779, Samuel moved to Washington Co., PA.

Samuel served in the military in PA., 15 OCT 1781. Samuel is listed in Western PA. serving in Captain William Crawford's Company along the Monongahela River between the Whitley and Muddy Creeks. (PA. Archives, 6th Series, Vol 2, pp. 166, 172, 250). Samuel enlisted again as a private in Washington Co., under the command of Captain Crawford's Pennsylvania Company where he served until June 1782. The coverage of the rededication of the DAR Marker in Georgetown, Scott, KY. listed Samuel as a private in the Pennsylvania Militia who served at Mc Clelland's fort and eventually settled near Muddy Fort and died being buried at the old home place.

He married Elizabeth Fire in Washington Co., PA., ca 1782. Daniel Barnhill records suggest that marriage was as early as 1780

At 20 years of age Samuel became the father of Samuel Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., 1782. Samuel became the father of James Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., ca 1785. At 31 years of age Samuel became the father of Robert Barnhill Sr. in Washington Co., PA, 1793. At 31 years of age Samuel became the father of Nancy Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., 20 AUG 1793. He migrated ca 1795. According to Dwayne Barnhill (of New Tazewell, TN), many of the Barnhill family traveled westward to Ohio, Kentucky and Tennessee. The Barnhills of Scptt Cpimtu. Kentucky, were just one of many families who traveled by raft, flatboat or canoe down the Ohio River to Pioneer new opportunities in the expanding west. Most likely, they entered Kentucky at Limestone (Maysville) near the end of the 18th century, and by 1795, had settled on the banks of the south fork of Eagle Creek in Scott County. As farmers, they sought the fertile bluegrass section of Kentucky.'

A census listed Samuel as head of household in Scott County, Kentucky, 1795. Samuel appears on the 1795 Tax list of Scott Co., KY.

At 35 years of age Samuel became the father of John Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., 17 JAN 1797. Samuel registered to pay taxes in Scott County, Kentucky, 1797. Samuel registered to pay taxes in Scott County, Kentucky, 1799. He resided in Scott County, Kentucky 1800. Samuel is not the Samuel who appears on the list of Taxables (Lists of Inhabitants in Washington Co., Penna., 1800 or Before, p. 61). Rather, he is listed along with his brother Daniel in the 1800 Tax list of Scott Co., KY.

At 39 years of age Samuel became the father of Daniel Barnhill in Scott County, Kentucky, 29 DEC 1800. At 41 years of age Samuel became the father of Sarah 'Sallie' Barnhill in Scott County, Kentucky, 1803. Samuel became the father of Joseph Barnhill aft 1803. Samuel became the father of Mary Barnhill aft 1803. Samuel was listed as the head of a family on the 1810 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Very possibly, the enumeration includes an additional (unidentified) family living with Samuel and his family.

Samuel was listed as the head of a family on the 1820 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Samuel listed on reel number 99 at line number 24.

Samuel was listed as the head of a family on the 1830 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. The census shows two Samuels, one the father born in 1761, and the other the son along with sons John and Robert.

Samuel applied for a military pension in Scott County, Kentucky, 15 NOV 1832. Samuel is listed as 72 years old on his revolutionary war pension application.

Samuel was listed as the head of a family on the 1840 Census in Scott County, Kentucky. Samuel listed as 82 years old

Samuel died 25 FEB 1844 in Scott County, Kentucky, at 82 years of age. Samuel died at the home

of his daughter Sarah and son-in-law James Vance.

His body was interred 1844 in Shawnee Run, Georgetown, Scott, KY., Vance Cemetery.

### 13 Elizabeth Fire

Elizabeth was born in Bucks Co., PA. ca 1762/3. She married Samuel Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., ca 1782. Daniel Barnhill records suggest that marriage was as early as 1780

At 19 years of age Elizabeth became the mother of Samuel Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., 1782. Elizabeth became the mother of James Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., ca 1785. At 30 years of age Elizabeth became the mother of Robert Barnhill Sr. in Washington Co., PA, 1793. At 30 years of age Elizabeth became the mother of Nancy Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., 20 AUG 1793. At 33 years of age Elizabeth became the mother of John Barnhill in Washington Co., PA., 17 JAN 1797. At 37 years of age Elizabeth became the mother of Daniel Barnhill in Scott County, Kentucky, 29 DEC 1800. At 40 years of age Elizabeth became the mother of Sarah 'Sallie' Barnhill in Scott County, Kentucky, 1803. Elizabeth became the mother of Joseph Barnhill aft 1803. Elizabeth became the mother of Mary Barnhill aft 1803.

### 14 James Nealy

James was born in Scotland ca 1745. He married Ann ? ca 1765. At 45 years of age James became the father of Margaret Neeley in North Carolina, 1790. Barnhill Papers of EE Barton suggests that Margaret may have been born in PA. LDS AFN V4PL-DV suggests that Margaret was possibly born as early as 1785 near Nelson / Washington, KY.

### 15 Ann ?

Ann was born ca 1745. She married James Nealy ca 1765. At 45 years of age Ann became the mother of Margaret Neeley in North Carolina, 1790. Barnhill Papers of EE Barton suggests that Margaret may have been born in PA. LDS AFN V4PL-DV suggests that Margaret was possibly born as early as 1785 near Nelson / Washington, KY.

### 24 Samuel Barnhill

Samuel was born in Ireland 1732. He married Jane Craig in Bucks Co., PA., ca 1753. Daniel Barnhill suggests that the marriage was as late as 1760 to Jane Craig.

Samuel became the father of Alexander Barnhill in PA., bef 1761. He resided in Bucks Co., PA. FEB 1761. Samuel contributed three shillings for the building of a home for Reverend James Latta, pastor of Deep Run Presbyterian Church.

At 29 years of age Samuel became the father of Samuel Barnhill in Bucks Co., PA., 29 OCT 1761. Based on revolutionary war pensions application S. 10344, Samuel may have been born on December 29th 1761.

Samuel became the father of James Barnhill in PA., aft 1761. He purchased land JUN 1763 in Bucks Co. PA. Samuel acquired property from his brother-in-law Archibald Finley based on records found in The Bucks Co., PA, Bk 11, p. 31.

At 31 years of age Samuel became the father of Mary Barnhill in Bucks Co., PA., 17 APR 1764. Samuel became the father of Jane Barnhill in PA., ca 1763/73. He purchased land 1765 in Bucks Co., PA. Samuel purchased a farm from William Miller along the county line in Warrington Township. (1765 Deed Records, Bucks Co., PA., Bk 11, p. 560) This farm was sold on December 1, 1766. In 1768, he sold what has been described as the homestead to Jacob Guile for 750 pounds. It had considerable improvements and contained 153 acres. On December 4 1772, he signed a Power of Attorney to Isaac Hicks to satisfy the mortgage against Jacob Guile, but no residence was given.

At 34 years of age Samuel became the father of Daniel Barnhill in PA., 1766. Samuel became the father of William Barnhill in PA., aft 1767. Daniel Barnhill records suggest no year of birth.

At 36 years of age Samuel became the father of Robert Barnhill in PA., 28 FEB 1769. Samuel registered to pay taxes in Tredyffrin Tp., Chester, PA., 1771. He purchased land 10 NOV 1774 in Frederick L. Lager

Saturday, June 17, 2000

Juaniata/Tyrone Tp., Cumberland, PA. Samuel purchased 219 acres and a survey on the tract twenty years later in 1794 referenced it as the property of the late Samuel Barnhill.

Samuel died bef 29 SEP 1794 in Cumberland Co., PA., at approximately 62 years of age. One researcher suggests that Samuel may have gone on with the rest of his family to KY., Another suggests that he went to SC.

## 25 Jane Craig

Jane was born in Bucks Co., PA. ca 1734. She married Samuel Barnhill in Bucks Co., PA., ca 1753. Daniel Barnhill suggests that the marriage was as late as 1760 to Jane Craig.

Jane became the mother of Alexander Barnhill in PA., bef 1761. At 27 years of age Jane became the mother of Samuel Barnhill in Bucks Co., PA., 29 OCT 1761. Based on revolutionary war pensions application S. 10344, Samuel may have been born on December 29th 1761.

Jane became the mother of James Barnhill in PA., aft 1761. At 29 years of age Jane became the mother of Mary Barnhill in Bucks Co., PA., 17 APR 1764. Jane became the mother of Jane Barnhill in PA., ca 1763/73. At 32 years of age Jane became the mother of Daniel Barnhill in PA., 1766. Jane became the mother of William Barnhill in PA., aft 1767. Daniel Barnhill records suggest no year of birth.

At 34 years of age Jane became the mother of Robert Barnhill in PA., 28 FEB 1769. Jane died aft 1769 in Cumberland Co., PA.

## 48 Robert Barnhill

Robert was born in County Antrim, Northern Ireland 10 JUN 1703. He married Sarah ? in County Antrim, Northern Ireland, bef 1729. At 26 years of age Robert became the father of John Barnhill in Ireland, 1729. At 29 years of age Robert became the father of Samuel Barnhill in Ireland, 1732. At 31 years of age Robert became the father of Sarah Barnhill 1734. Robert immigrated, 28 SEP 1734. Destination: destination unknown. Based on the papers and collection of Mrs. Emma Dunn Mastin, of Owensboro, KY, DAR Library Washington DC, it is likely that Robert Barnhill disembarked at New Castle, Delaware before traveling to Philadelphia.

He resided in Bedminister Tp., Bucks, PA. aft 1734. It is believed that Robert settled near Deep Run Stream. Daniel Barnhill suggests that the family settled in New Brittain township of Bucks County.

At 31 years of age Robert became the father of William Barnhill in Northern Ireland, 04 MAY 1735. Robert became the father of Robert Barnhill bef 1736. At 33 years of age Robert became the father of Isabella Barnhill 1736. Robert became the father of Abraham Barnhill aft 1736. He purchased land 18 MAR 1737 in Bucks Co., PA. Robert purchased 400 acres near the forks of the Delaware which was recorded by Thomas Penn the son of William Penn.

He resided in Bucks Co., PA. JUN 1738. Robert appeared as one of the petitioners for the opening of the road from Butlers Mill through New Britain and Plumstead Townships, to the Durham Road to connect there with the road leading to Hughes Ferry on the Delaware River. He also leased 212 acres of land in New Britian from John Kirkbride, which he later purchased in 1744.

At 35 years of age Robert became the father of Margaret Barnhill 1738. Robert died bef JUN 1768 in PA. At this time, his son Samuel sold the homestead of his father which had been previously conveyed to him.

## 49 Sarah ?

Sarah was born in Ireland 1707/8. She married Robert Barnhill in County Antrim, Northern Ireland, bef 1729. At 21 years of age Sarah became the mother of John Barnhill in Ireland, 1729. At 24 years of age Sarah became the mother of Samuel Barnhill in Ireland, 1732. At 26 years of age Sarah became the mother of Sarah Barnhill 1734. At 26 years of age Sarah became the mother of William Barnhill in Northern Ireland, 04 MAY 1735. Sarah became the mother of Robert Barnhill bef 1736. At 28 years of age Sarah became the mother of Isabella Barnhill 1736. Sarah became the mother of Abraham Barnhill aft 1736. At 30 years of age Sarah became the mother of Margaret Barnhill 1738. Sarah died aft 1738 in Bucks Co., PA.

**50 Daniel Craig**

Daniel was born in Bucks Co., PA. 1708. PEGHAM@aol.com suggests that birth was in 1691 in County Tyrone, Ulster, Ireland.

He married Margaret Stewart bef 1725. At 17 years of age Daniel became the father of Mary Margaret Craig 1725. Daniel became the father of Mary Lewis Craig aft 1725. At 22 years of age Daniel became the father of Sarah Craig in Warrington Tp., Bucks, PA., 1730. Daniel became the father of William Craig aft 1730.
