

Preface - Email Message from Virginia Tolman- July 29, 2001

Here's the latest update on Thomas Bishop and his descendants --  
This is what I CAN PROVE and feel comfortable with.

ANYTHING I sent previously is WRONG. I've been through the records still not finished -- but William Bishop who married Rebecca Homewood is the son of Elijah Bishop--there is a court case that proves this. John and Joshua and a William are brothers but not sons of Thomas -- information indicates that they are the sons of James Bishop and Sarah Isom. Otherwise they are related to Elijah Bishop -- but not related to Thomas.

Information indicates that Joshua Bishop born 1753 was not the son of Thomas but the son of James Bishop and Sarah Isom. He evidently divorced his first wife and remarried and went to live in Surry Co, Virginia, where he raised a second family -- he died 1822 and Hannah was very much alive at that time and his wife at that time was Elizabeth

I've included sources and notes. I've also attached a file in RTF format that has additional information.

I found the original document for Joshua Bishop born 1753 in fact two of them -  
- one has no documentation at all other than Frederick Co., Virginia marriages and give his father's name as Thomas -- it looked as if the person had just went into the Frederick Co., Va. marriages and stuck them in a family and found a father's name and that was it. The other is in the Ancestral file at the library and seems to be better documented gives the father as James.

Sorry about the mix up. I still have a lot of notes and other records to go through and these families and my son wants me to come down for August so it will be later this fall before I get anything more done. Virginia
