Will of Silvester Tingle:

"August 18th 1842

I SILVESTER TINGLE of the County of Craven and State of North Carolina do make and ordain This my last Will and testament and first I direct that my body be deasantly Enterd and As it respects my Natural affairs I leave and despose of as fowloes ---

It 1 --- I leave my Negro woman Gilly and her child and my house and plantation and my half of a boat to be Sold to pay my honest debts

It 2 and all the balance of my property after my Just debts is paid I give and bequeath to my Beloved Wife SARAH during her Natural life.

It 3 I leave and recomend my worthy friend Noah Miller Exector to this my last will and testament in witness thereof I have hereunto Let my hand and Seal in the preseance of Zachary Squires
