


In the twentysixth day of the Ninth Month called Novemb^r in the year
 of our Lord God one thousand six hundred ninety and five ~ I Walter Bowoll of the
 Province of Maryland in the County of Somerset being very Sick and
 W^{ake} of Body y^{et} of good & perfect memory Do make and ordaine this my last
 will & testament in Maner following ~ first I Comitt my Soule into the hand
 of God hoping and believing I shall find Mercy with Christ Iesus the Light
 of the World and my body to be Buried from whence it was taken ~

- 1 Item I give & bequeath unto my son W^m Bowoll the Plantation knowne by the name
 called Greenfield & fifty acres of Land called Bolls addition with one hundred acres
 of Land joyning to the March of the Tract of Land called Winter Quarter and com-
 munion of the whole march. s^hely for pasturage called Bowolls Lott lying on
 the South side of s^d Bowolls Lott and one Oxen Drawers and my hand Mill
 to him, to him the s^d W^m his heirs and assigns for ever ~
- 2 Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Bowoll my Plantation called Winter
 Quarter on the Sea side unto him & said John Bowoll his heirs & assigns forever
- 3 Item I give and bequeath unto my two Daughters (viz) Eliza: Tingle & Mary & one
 one tract of Land called Hilliards Dejeours & one tract of Land more called
 Bowolls Mill ponds containeing two hundred and fifty acres for which have beene
 for to be Examined by the s^d two tracts containeing three hundred & thirty
 acres, to be equally divided between my said two Daughters Eliza: and Mary their
 heirs and assigns for ever ~ Now the s^d tract containeing two hundred and forty acres
 of Land called Bowolls Mill ponds the purchase thereof is to be p^d before
 Division of my Movable Estate ~
- 4 Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Margaret Schofield one tract of Land
 called Peabers portion lying at the Sea side containeing one hundred and fifty
 acres of Land to her the s^d Margaret her heirs and assigns for ever ~
- 5 Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Catharine Bowoll one tract of Land
 containeing one hundred & fifty acres of Land called Froids Gift lying
 at the Sea side in Sumersett County to her the said Catharine her heirs &
 assigns for ever ~
- 6 Item I give and bequeath unto all my grandchildren one cow to each or cows ~
 follows that is to say one heifer of two years old ~
- 7 Item I give and bequeath all the rest of my movable Estate to be equally
 divided among my six Children above mentioned to wit W^m J^r Eliza: Mary
 Margaret, Catharine, and my Daughter Sarah to be equally divided as aforesaid
- 8 Item the tract of Land called Bowolls Lott is something Indebted my order is that it
 be satisfied and paid out of my Movable Estate before Division ~
- 9 Item My will is that if either of my Sons die without Issue to wit my Sons
 W^m and J^r, the Survivor or Inheritt ~

- 10 Item If my Daughte: Catharine die without Issue, then her Estate to be Equally Divided amongst the rest of my surviving Children.
- 11 Item I Ordaine and appoint my three Sons Namely W^m. Bowell Joⁿ. Bowell & Henry Schote first my Sole Ex^r & of this my Last will and Testament and when ever it please god to take me out of this world I give my Body unto him. & my body unto my friends called Quakers, my body to be buried according to their Manner, and this I do declare to my last will and Testament, in my Deare Love to all my friends and my Children, farewell

In the name of God Amen, I Charles Rackliff of Somers^{set} County in good health, of Body and of sound and perfect memory praise to all mighty God for, Make and ordaine, this my present Last will and Testament in Manner and forme following that is to wit First and principally I commend my soule unto the hands of Almighty God hoping through the Meritts death and passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have full and free pardon and forgiveness of all my sins and to inherit Everlasting Life, & my body committed to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Ex^r & hereafter named and as touching the Disposition of all such temporall Estate as it hath pleased almighty God to bestow upon me, I give and bequeath dispose thereof as followeth. First I will that my debts and financial Charges shall be first paid and discharged
