TOM KERMIT TINGLE OF MISSISSIPPI AND TENNESSEE (1930-1966)

In Vol. 5 - No. 1 Fall 1991 issue of "TINGLE DESCENDANTS" we carried an appealing story, titled "Proud Memories Blooming Anew." It told of the valiant widow of a paratrooper, Staff Sergeant Tom K. Tingle, who was killed in Viet Nam. At the request of your editor, Mrs. Ann T. Lila of Mesa, Arizona, sister of Tom, has supplied the additional information about his family which is described below. Thank you, Ann, for sharing this poignant description of your sister-in-law, her brave husband and their three sons.

Ann also prepared a Family Group Listing and "The Tingle Family Tree" for this branch of the Tingles which was computerized by her nephew Robert. It is a pleasure to reproduce them in the newsletter. Note that there are eight generations of Tingles, going back to Solomon of North Carolina.

MARGARETE (MARGRET) NIEMANN TINGLE

At age 36, upon the untimely death of her husband, Margret was left a widow with three sons to rear. She established a home in Clarksville, Tennessee, near Fort Campbell and became a valued member of her community through church and volunteer activities. When her sons were Boy Scouts, she became a den mother. Her sons absorbed their mother's enthusiasm for an active life, always ready to help neighbors and friends. They learned the value of a dollar which they earned and how to spend it wisely.

When Russian soldiers arrived in eastern Germany near the close of World War Two, they stabled their horses in the Niemann home and took whatever they wished of their belongings.

Margret knew the pain of hunger felt by so many German people during and after the war. She said she could never waste a bite of food after she arrived in the United States where there was such an abundance to eat, because of the memories of hunger in Germany.

After her escape from East to West Germany in the 1950's, she worked for an American Army colonel and his family in the Mainz area. Margret's sister, and later her father, came to Mainz too. It would be 1990, over 35 years later, before she could return to East Germany to visit some of her brothers and sisters from whom she became separated by "The Wall" between East and West.

Margret is loved by her American kinsmen. She and her sons have brought great credit to the Tingle name. Tom Kermit Tingle who was awarded the Silver Star posthumously for his action in battle, lost his life in Long Khanh Province 49 miles north of Saigon on Easter Sunday, 10 April 1966, while serving with Company A, 2nd Battalion, 16th Infantry, First Infantry Division, in Viet Nam. He would be so proud of his family if he could see them today. "

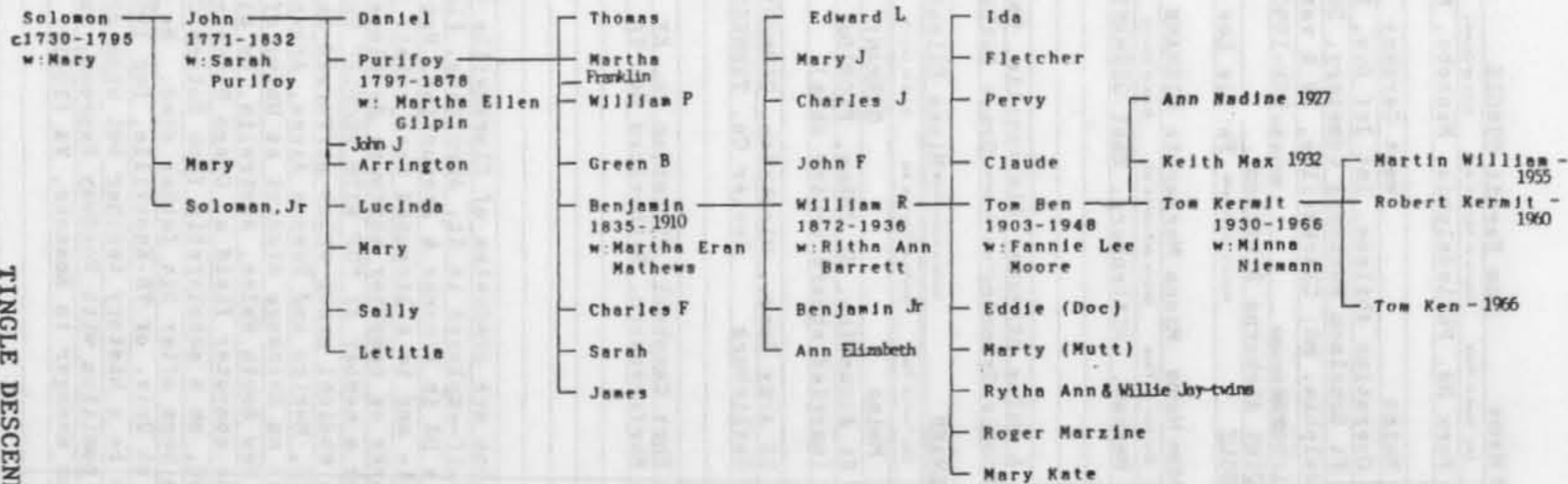

DAVID PAUL BROWN TINGLE OF MARYLAND (1844-1913)
AND HIS SON JOHN PAUL TINGLE (1875-1964)

The previous issue of the newsletter carried an interesting story about David Paul Brown Tingle and his pardon by President Lincoln. Written by our treasurer, Mrs. Sarah E.T. Everding, it drew a quick response from one of our readers, Mr. John Tingle Coady of St. Michaels, Maryland, who is a great grandson of David P.B. Tingle. Thank you Mr. Coady for giving us this family history. That's what the newsletter is all about!

"Dear Mrs. Everding:

I always look forward to the Tingle newsletter. However, I was thrilled about your article in Volume 5 #3 concerning your great-uncle, David Paul Brown Tingle.

David was my great-grandfather. His son, John Paul Tingle, my grandfather, had three girls; Lucille, Deborah and my mother, Emma.

My grandfather, John Paul Tingle, would often tell us that his father, David, could knock a squirrel's head off at 100 yards with his rifle.

Mary Elizabeth Tingle did obtain a written pardon from President Lincoln, according to my grandfather. However, because of her intense dislike of President Lincoln, she destroyed the pardon after she got her son home.

My grandfather was raised in Berlin, Maryland. At 18 years of age his family "arranged" for him to marry a Miss Henry, who was the Church organist at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Berlin, and who was several years his senior. The evening before the wedding he got cold feet and left town for Philadelphia. He later moved to Baltimore and married Deborah Ann Barnes. The older residents of Berlin still remember Mr. Tingle's leaving poor Miss Henry "on the Church steps".

THOMAS JEFFERSON TINGLE OF ALABAMA (1813-1893)

Mrs. Ann Tingle Lila of Mesa, Arizona, tireless and longtime dedicated staff member of this newsletter has supplied photocopies of two interesting "Claims for Pensions." They relate to Thomas Jefferson Tingle who served in the military service of the United States in the war with the Creek Indians. The likelihood exists that he was the son of Solomon Tingle of Hancock County, Georgia.

Thomas Jefferson Tingle's claim for a pension was filed 25 Feb. 1893, just two months before his death on 21 April at age 80. It stated that he was a resident of Mellville, Winston County, Alabama, having served as a Private from April 1836 to June that year in the Company of Captain Thomas Lackins, Alabama Volunteers, the Regiment being commanded by Colonels Graves and Turner. He cited participation in the following engagement - "after we captured a band of indians I served as a guard until we got ready to send them a way."

TJT further stated on his claim that he was born in Hancock (sic) County, Georgia, and at the time of military service was "23 years of age, 5 feet 7 inches high, of fair complexion, blue eyes, dark hair, and a farmer by occupation." He also said he was married at Paldwin (Paulding) County, Georgia on 11 Dec. 1838 to Elisabeth Dannel (Daniel), who is 'dead.' The claim was duly attested by David A. Tingle (possibly the son of TJT) and by Francis M. Tingle (relationship undetermined).

The other claim paper was that of "Widow for Service Pension of Indian Wars," filed 2 June 1893 by the second wife of TJT, who was Pheby Cagle. She stated that she was "age 70 and that she was married to Thomas J. Tingle at her father's residence in Pauldon (Paulding) County, Georgia on 4 Feb. 1841." She further said that "my husband had been married to Elisabeth Daniel who died in Georgia, May 1839." It mentions "that her husband died at his son's (sic), B.F. Tingle, in Alabama on 27 April 1893."

Phoebe Cagle Tingle said that she and her husband resided in Pauldon (Paulding) County, Georgia until 1853 when they moved to Alabama, living thereafter in Benton, Jefferson, Walker and Winston Counties. She added that she was born in More (Moore) County, North Carolina on 28 April 1823.

These two historical records contained a wealth of family history and we are indebted to Mrs. Lila for having made them available in the pages of our newsletter.

LINEAGE CHARTS OF THE WILLIAM BERNER TINGLE FAMILY

Mrs. Joan K. Tingle of Valley Center, California sent the two Family Group Listings and the Ancestor Chart for her husband's family which are reproduced in this issue. Their daughter, Caroline, (a red-head like her Uncle Nick) is in the 7th grade."

"David is a masonry contractor but is currently the head of the bricklayers' union in this area - good pay while building is off. His wife is a laboratory technician at a LaMesa hospital. Their twins, David William and Stephen Alex are in the 8th grade."

"Dan went to Santa Barbara to study at Brooks Institute of Photography. Then played in a band with his wife and now is a distributor for a soft drink company to support his family, while he writes childrens' books, etc. Their baby, Dylan, will be a year old Feb. 20th (1992)."

R. C. Tingle Wounded Second Time 1945

Pfc. R. C. Tingle has again been seriously wounded in action according to a message received Friday by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Fletcher Tingle of 221 Myrtle St. from Adjutant General J. A. Ullo which read: "Regret to inform you your son, Pfc. R. C. Tingle was seriously wounded in action the twenty fifth of January in Luxembourg. Further report stated he had returned to duty on January 3rd from previous reported wound. Mail address follows direct from hospital with details."

Pfc. Tingle was wounded in the first invasion of France and had been in the hospital until Jan. 3rd when he returned to duty to be wounded again on Jan. 25th.

Mr. and Mrs. Tingle have four sons in the armed forces, the last one to go left Friday, only a few minutes after the message came about his brother. He is Orville Burton Tingle, eighteen and is on his way to Great Lakes, Ill. Cpl. Fletcher Tingle Jr. is in India and Pvt. Charles W. Tingle is in the Philippines. They have one other child, a son who is nine.
