GLADYS TINGLE MEDLOCK OF GEORGIA (1898-1972)

One of the most interesting Tingle descendants that it has been our pleasure to learn about is the late Gladys Tingle Medlock of Atlanta, Georgia. While we carried a brief mention of her back in the fall of 1990 (Vol. 4 - No. 1, pp 15-16), it is only through a new member of the Tingle Descendants, who is a great niece, that we are now able to gain more knowledge about this talented and judicious woman.

Thanks to Mrs. Benae Proctor of Forsyth, Georgia, we reproduce a photo of Gladys Tingle Medlock taken from a copy of "Business and Professional Women of Georgia" in the Washington Memorial Library, Macon, Georgia and her obituary in the "Atlanta Journal and Constitution".

Gladys Tingle was born in Jackson, Georgia, on 23 Dec. 1898 and died in Atlanta in September 1972. She married Marvin W. Medlock on 23 April 1934. She was survived by her husband and a brother, Mortimer L. Tingle of Forsyth. Her parents were Lemuel Elmo Tingle and his second wife, Harriet Mackey.

The business paper cited above stated, "On her mother's side, she is a descendant of the Nelson family of England and of the Mackey family; on her father's side she is a descendant of the Tingle family, who were pioneers in the settling of Georgia." Through the pages of our family newsletter we know that she was a direct descendant, in the sixth generation, of Solomon Tingle, who died in Craven County, North Carolina, in 1794/5 and whose son, John, migrated to Georgia shortly before the beginning of the nineteenth century. Thank you, Mrs. Proctor, for sharing your mementoes with the readers of our newsletter.

Services for Dr. Gladys Tingle Medlock, 1149 St. Charles Place NE, law assistant to Judge B. C. Gardner for 20 years, a practicing attorney and an officer in a number of organizations, will be at 11:30 a.m. Tuesday at Spring Hill, entombment in Westview Abby.

Dr. Medlock, wife of Marvin W. Medlock, was the former Gladys Tingle of High Falls. She died Sunday.

She was admitted to practice law in all courts up to the U.S. Supreme Court. She was a graduate of the Atlanta Conservatory of Music, Draughton's School of Commerce, the University of Georgia, the Atlanta Law School with both a bachelor's and master's degree, Emory University with two degrees, Balckstone College of Law with a Ph.D. degree and she studied at the American Research Institute, the Lamar School of Law and at Emory University.

She was elected internal supreme dean of Iota Tau Tau, international legal sorority, at the Baltimore convention in 1957. She was a past vice president of the Atlanta Woman's Club and since 1944 had been a life member. She was the past president of the Women's Auxiliary to Local 32 of the National Federation of Post Office Clerks, a member and for three years Georgia chairman of the National Women's Party, past presi-

Dr. Medlock served as Georgia chairman, regional director and as state delegate of the National Association of Women Lawyers. She was a member of the Georgia Bar Association and served on the Committee on Unauthorized Practice of Law for several years and was vice chairman of the committee in 1956. She was chairman of the Workmen's Compensation Committee of the Georgia Bar Association, a charter member of the International Association of Women Lawyers.

She was chairman of the Department of Legislation of the Georgia Federation of Women's Clubs for six years, a member of the Fulton Democratic Club, legislative director of the American Legion's Girls' State project, a member of the Appeals Reference Board under the Georgia Department of Labor from 1938 to 1961, a member and secretary of the State Personnel Board from 1938 to 1945, and a director of the Rho Chapter of Beta Sigma Phi business women's sorority.

She was the only woman ever to manage a statewide political campaign.

She had held all offices in the Atlanta chapter of Iota Tau Tau. She was listed in Who's Who and the International Blue Book from 1943 to date, the Marquis Who's Who and the Social Register.

She was appointed by the International Association of Women Lawyers to represent that group as an observer at the United Nations with the Committee on Discrimination in 1956.

Survivors include her husband; and a brother, M. L. Tingle, Forsyth.

THE APPEL - TINGLE CONNECTION

Dr. Frederick W. Appel of Washington, D.C. is a great grandson of George E. Tingle (middle name was probably 'Edmund') of Virginia, Kentucky, Indiana and Washington, D.C. He is now 94 years old.

He has always been interested in the genealogy of his Tingle ancestry through his maternal grandmother, Jane Virginia Washington Tingle. After his mother's death in 1958, he found that she had kept a great hoard of old letters, keepsakes and photographs. Dr. Appel put them into a semblance of order and then wrote A Revised History of Several Tingle and Bennit Families, which told about his mother's people. He had the book published and copyrighted in 1980.

Dr. Appel writes in an engaging style. One marvels at the amount of time he spent in digesting and sorting all the material inherited from his mother. With his permission, we are pleased to reproduce his chart of the "Principal Members of the Extended Tingle Family With Their Birth and Death Years".

A pleasant surprise greeted your editor recently with a letter from our long-time staff member, Ann Tingle Lila, in which she enclosed a photo of eight members of her family.

Ann has been an ardent supporter of our newsletter from its inception. She is the wife of Paul Peter Lila, and they had three sons. Ann was born 23 Oct. 1927 in Philadelphia, Neshoba County, Mississippi, the daughter of Tom Ben Tingle and Fannie Lee Moore Tingle. Her Tingle ancestry goes back to Solomon Tingle who died 1794/5 in Craven County, North Carolina. The ensuing generations during the past 200 years have been thoroughly documented by Ann. She is a very special genealogist.

BURTON M. TINGLE OF DELAWARE AND MARYLAND (1854 - 1922)
AND SOME OF DESCENDANTS AND ANCESTORS!

Two of our younger readers are Darrell and Becky Fisher of Frankford, Delaware. They have been interested in tracing Darrell's descent through the Tingle line. When they started they could go no further back than his grandmother, Helen Frances Tingle, who married Oliver John Fisher in 1931. They were natives of Gumboro, Sussex County, Delaware.

Thanks to another new reader, Elisha (Peanut) Tingle of Frankford, it develops that he is a brother of Darrell's late grandmother, the above Helen Frances Tingle, who died 9 March 1992. Elisha and Helen were two of the eight children of Elisha E. Tingle (1890 - 1943) and his wife, Bessie M. Evans (1887 - 1956).

Elisha E. Tingle was one of the five children of Burton M. Tingle (1854 - 1922) and his wife, Janie Brumbly (1856 - 1932). This family lived at various times in both Delaware and Maryland, close to the state line. They are buried in Bethel M. E. Cemetery, half of which is in Delaware and half in Maryland. Family group charts are included with this article.

Tracing this Tingle line back another generation shows that the father of Burton M. Tingle was Albert Tingle, b. 30 Aug. 1832. Albert Tingle married Mahala (Margaret) Baker (1835 - 1913). His name is written as 'Abbend' in the Bible of his brother, Mana'an Tingle (1830 - 1915). Vol. 4 - No. 1, pp. 18-20 of our newsletter contains a story about this line.

Albert and Mana'an Tingle were two of the nine children of William Tingle (1804 - ?) and his wife, Catherine Long (1804 - ?). The 1860 census for Sussex County, Delaware, shows this latter family living in Bulls Mill P.O. in Broad Creek Hundred with two children. Minos B. Tingle, age 4 and Catherine J. Tingle, age 3. Minos B. (or Burton M.) Tingle is listed on the 1900 census with wife, Janie Brumbly, and six children.

The above William Tingle (b. 4 Nov. 1804) was one of the six children of James Tingle of Delaware (ca 1764/5 - 1848/9) and his wife, Leah Lockwood (ca 1769 - 1850). James and Leah emigrated in 1828 to Eaton, Preble County, Ohio, with at least three of their six children, but William remained in Delaware.

From all of the above it can be seen that Darrell L. Fisher is a descendant of James Tingle in the eighth generation. Elisha (Peanut) Tingle is a descendant in the sixth generation. More and more descendants of this James Tingle, now living in others states, are beginning to show an interest in their Tingle ancestry. Your editor urges them to search for clues, such as old family Bibles, to try to identify this James Tingle. He may be a great grandson of Hugh Tingle, the progenitor, but that statement remains to be proved.

EDWIN HENRY TINGLE (1897 - 1945)
OF MARYLAND AND PENNSYLVANIA

A surprise phone call from Canada this past February resulted in a pleasant conversation with a previously unidentified Tingle descendant. It turned out to be Mrs. Betsy T. McIntyre of Aurora, Ontario, who is the daughter of JOHN SHIBE TINGLE and his wife, ELIZABETH FRAME TINGLE. Mrs. Ann T. Lila, our alert staff member, was responsible for making this connection.

Mrs. McIntyre's father was the son of EDWIN HENRY TINGLE and his wife, MARGARET SWIFT TINGLE. Edwin Henry was born 22 Feb. 1897 at Berlin, Worcester County, Maryland and died 9 Aug. 1945 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He was one of the six children of Emerson Tingle (1852 - 1928) and his wife, Annie Kate Ennis Tingle (1862 - 1937).

Emerson Tingle was a son of "Gentleman John" Tingle (1798 - 1868) and his second wife, Mary A. E. Bowen (1825 - 1911). The latter apparently acquired the sobriquet "Gentleman John" because of never having worked a day in his life, according to the story which appeared in Vol. 4 - No. 2, pp. 3 - 4 of our newsletter.

This line of Tingles traces its ancestry directly back to Hugh Tingle, the progenitor. Consequently, Betsy Tingle McIntyre is a ninth generation descendant. In a subsequent letter she included some interesting family history--any baseball fans on our mailing list will enjoy it.

She relates: "In speaking with my father, and from a bio of my grandmother's (Margaret Swift), I have found out that my grandfather, Edwin, met my grandmother on the subway in Philadelphia. They both traveled on the subway to their places of employment. Edwin worked in a restaurant as a waiter at 19th and Market St, Philadelphia. They were married at St. Agatha's Church, 58th and Spring Garden Street, Philadelphia, and they honeymooned in Atlantic City. Their first home, an apartment, was located at 39th and Barring Street, Philadelphia. The last address I know of was 60th Street, Philadelphia, where my grandfather died of a heart attack.

According to the bio, the restaurant where Edwin worked was a favorite spot for many major league ballplayers. Edwin's friendship with John Shibe (for whom Shibe Park in Philadelphia was named) caused him to name one of his sons John Shibe Tingle (my father). Mr. Shibe was so honored, he granted Edwin the privilege of free entry to Shibe Park for all the games played there.

I questioned my father regarding Shibe, as his middle name, because he has always been known to me as John Joseph. My father tells me, "Yes, it was Shibe." However, he could not be christened in the Catholic Church without a Christen name, so he became John Joseph."

Back in the fall of 1990, we ran an interesting story and picture of an EMERSON TINGLE FAMILY REUNION (Vol. 4 - No. 1, pp 3 - 4). Our picture was a poor reproduction of the original but this time we are able to do better. The eight persons shown are all first cousins--their fathers were all sons of EMERSON TINGLE. Missing from this photo was Jack Tingle, i.e. John Shibe Tingle, christened John Joseph Tingle, who was the father of Betsy Tingle McIntyre.

At present, I and my two sons, Mike and Tim, are still located in Aurora.

I am presently employed locally as an Executive Secretary for the Ontario Retail Farm Equipment Dealers Association(O.R.F.E.D.A)."
