MORE ABOUT THE NAME 'TINGLE' IN OHIO!

Ms. Elaine Mitchell of Lakewood, Ohio has sent another clipping which poses a challenge for Tingle researchers. This involves a news item from the Yellow Springs, Ohio Review of Feb. 19, 1886. Yellow Springs is east of Dayton. It reads:

"Messrs. Tingle and Large have just received notice that the patent on their rocking chair has been granted. The back and seat are fastened together so they spring and fit to the shape of the back, and the weight comes on the rockers in three places. A new business is in town - a chair factory to produce the rocking chair recently patented."

MARY JANE TINGLE (1861 - 1884) OF MARYLAND AND DELAWARE
AND HER DESCENDANTS!

Thanks to the research of Mrs. Barbara Jane Hastings Jung of Bowie, Maryland, we are now able to reproduce her line of descent back to her great-grandmother, Mary Jane Tingle, who married Jessie Thomas Workman on 30 Nov. 1876. Mary Jane was one of eight children of Manaan Tingle (1830 - 1915) and his wife, Mary Truitt Tingle (1828 - 1897).

Readers of our newsletter recognize that Manaan was the son of William Tingle (1804 -) and his wife, Catherine Long Tingle (1804 -), and grandson of James Tingle (1765 - 1849) and his wife, Leah Lockwood Tingle (1769 - 1850).

Mrs. Jung's charts are enclosed and prove that she is a seventh generation descendant of James and Leah Tingle. Thank you Mrs. Jung for identifying ten Tingle descendants who were not in our records. She also included a chart for her great-grandfather, William Moses Hastings, even though he was not a Tingle descendant.

DESCENDANTS OF DANIEL WILLIE TINGLE (1796 - 1884)
AND PARTHENIA HATCHER TINGLE (1803 - 1878) OF GEORGIA!

Once again we are indebted to Boyd Monroe Tingle of Wimberley, Texas for supplying the interesting family picture shown herein. It was probably taken about 1909 at the old homestead of Archibald Daniel Tingle in Monroe County, Georgia. The four oldest Tingles are seated in the front row and are the children of Daniel Willie Tingle.

They are left to right:

Samantha Ann Tingle Jones (1827 - 1913)
Louisa (Liza) Jane Tingle Tollison (1825 - 1909)
Archibald Daniel Tingle (1835 - 1917), with child in his lap.
James Lafayette Tingle (1841 - 1930), to right of A. D. Tingle

MORE TINGLES IDENTIFIED ON THE DELMARVA PENINSULA!

Our last issue of the newsletter carried a brief story and charts on pages 5, 6, and 7 about Elizabeth Ann Tingle Eldridge and her father, John Ralph Tingle, of Sussex County, Delaware, and Wicomico County, Maryland. Also included was her aunt, Sadie Tingle Hadden, sister of John Ralph Tingle.

They are descendants of Charles Henry Tingle who married Annie Jane Dennis on 9 Jan. 1901. See charts prepared by Capt. Richard A. Eldridge, U.S.N. (Ret.)

Charles Henry Tingle (1879 - 1971) was the son of Burton M. Tingle, a.k.a. Minos B. Tingle (1854 - 1922) who married Jannie Brumbly (1856 - 1932). This line of Tingles is descended from James Tingle (1765 - 1849) and his wife, Leah Lockwood Tingle (1769 -1850). They lived in Sussex County, Delaware., but in 1828 emigrated to Eaton, Preble County, Ohio.

We are indebted to Capt Eldridge for documenting his wife's line of Tingle descent. He states that he will continue to search for clues about the early Tingles. Wouldn't it be nice to be able to identify the father of the aforementioned James!

'Daddy Mailed Us to Grandma's Farm!'



My daddy was the postmaster in Philadelphia, Mississippi, the small town where I grew up. No wonder he dreamed up the idea of "mailing" us to our grandparents' house in the country for our first trip away from home!

It was the summer of 1930. I was 6 years old and my sister, Sarah, was 5. We awoke on a beautiful morning and helped Mom pack our bags. Then Daddy drove us down to the post office, where he weighed us together on the big postage scales. He addressed a large tag, then added stamps and a postmark.

Next he took a long piece of twine, tied our wrists together and attached the tag. He even stamped our arms with "Fragile" and "Handle with Care".

After that, we crawled into the backseat of the car driven by Mr. Petty, our rural mail carrier. It was only 3 miles to our grandparents' home, but it seemed very far away at the time.

Childrens' trip to the country gave new meaning to the words "special delivery".

As we approached the house, Mr. Petty told us to duck on the floor so we wouldn't be seen. He blew his horn three times to let our grandparents know the mail had arrived. In the meantime, we snuck out of the backseat and hid behind a large oak tree near the mailbox.

Our grandpa, Pa Tingle, who knew about the

"special delivery", came walking down the hill. He looked in the mailbox and said, for our benefit, "Hmm, no mail today", and started to walk back to the house. Then we jumped out from behind the tree, yelling, "Surprise! Surprise! We're the mail today!"

As we walked up to the big white house on the hill, Grandma was sitting on the porch in her favorite rocking chair. She acted very surprised and said, "John, did you order these girls from Sears and Roebuck?"

"No," Grandpa replied, "but don't you think we ought to keep them for at least a week?" She agreed it was a good idea, saying we looked like we needed some good country sunshine and vittles.

This remains one of my fondest memories of my grandparents' wonderful farm, and of my parents, who made our first vacation away from them so memorable.

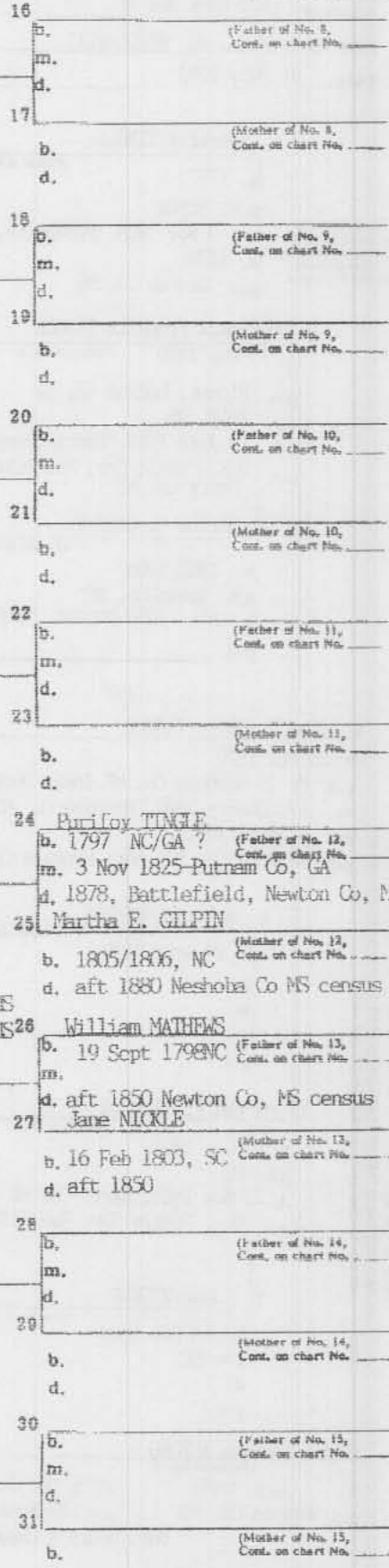

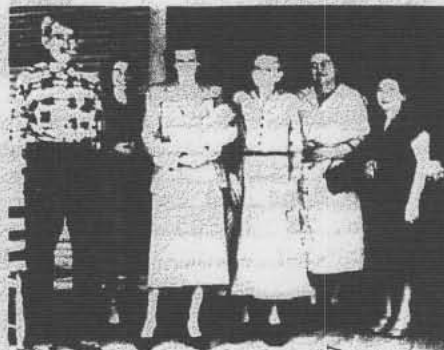

FIFTY YEARS LATER

On May 28, 1995, I attended the Women's Federation for World Peace conference at the Omni-Shoreham Hotel in Washington, D.C. They are a very dedicated group addressing world peace, world hunger, health issues, poverty and problems with youth. They have great hopes of finding ways to positively solve these problems.

The Federation has focused the year 1995 on the women of Japan. To make any progress with the important differences we have with Japan, especially trade, it may be up to the Japanese women and us, the women of America, to ameliorate and finally forge the spike to unite our two countries' relationships. One of the most compelling reasons against this goal is the Japanese sneak attack on Pearl Harbor December 7, 1941, and the subsequent atrocities committed by the Japanese that violated all international rules of war and human decency. No apology for these horrors has yet been made by the Japanese government. The women of Japan, it is said, were kept in complete ignorance of these infamous actions on the part of their government.

At the conference, following the luncheon, there was a bridge over which the American and the Japanese women met and embraced. Former President and Mrs. Bush gave separate addresses for peace which were very stimulating. The luncheon, reception and banquet, attended by several hundred people, were most impressive. Each American had a Japanese sister. Mine was Tomoya Sugimoto of Yokohama, a "young" lady of 44, who looked 28.

The foregoing ceremony led up to the dinner. There were six Americans, six Japanese and an interpreter at each table. The fact that I had mentioned in my bio how interested and involved I am in genealogy and the TINGLE DESCENDANTS in particular, the interpreter, Yasuko Takahashi, and Tomoyo showed great interest, so I gave them a abbreviated description of what we are about, and my own descendancy from Hugh Tingle, who arrived in America in 1869. Tomoyo's husband, Masaru, who was seated at another table, came over to ours and seemed very much intrigued as well. Although there was a language barrier, it seemed almost non-existent with the assistance of the interpreter. In the discussion that followed, Masaru appeared to have the same characteristics of an American, and not Japanese, at all. Heredity is of great importance to the Japanese.

All in all, it was a most enlightening experience, one which I wanted to share with our readers. Perhaps a formal Japanese apology to our country, for those Americans who died so horribly in World War II, will somehow help to eventually erase--but never totally obliterate--the wrongs done by the Japanese people against our people.

A month later, on my birthday, June 18, I received a wonderful surprise. My Japanese "sister" in Yokohama sent me 18 long-stemmed pink roses (minus the thorns).
